Eligibility Criteria

The NRIG Undergraduate Award will be awarded to a NRIG member who is currently enrolled in an undergraduate nursing program. Applicants must be a member of NRIG.

Completed applications must include the following

- 1. The completed application form found attached to this document (with signature)
- 2. <u>Original paper</u> (maximum 2 pages double spaced excluding Title Page and References)
 - Title Page
 - <u>Discussion Paper: What research means to you and how you would integrate research</u> into clinical practice
 - Bibliographic References

Formatting instructions: Use size 12, Times New Roman font, normal character spacing. Use double spacing and one inch margins on all sides throughout the document. Bibliographic references may be single spaced.

- 3. Proof of current student status
- 4. Photocopy of current RNAO/NRIG membership

Adjudication

- Allocation of funds will be based on quality and originality of written work.
- Preference will be given to a person identifying as BIPOC for one of these awards.
- Applicants will receive notice of the awards in the middle of May, 2023. The award will be recognized at the NRIG Annual General Meeting TBA 2023. Recipients are encouraged to attend.
- Name, bio and photo of award recipients will be posted on the NRIG website.

Deadline

All completed applications, including supporting documentation, must be received electronically by <u>midnight April 21, 2023</u>. ALL documents to be <u>submitted electronically by email</u> to the address noted below. It is preferred (but not mandatory) to have the above documents scanned into a single electronic file. It is the responsibility of the applicant to ensure that the complete application is received on time. Incomplete or late applications will not be reviewed.
